Years under each name is the year of their birth. Special notes: John Howland was probably the first member of the Mayflower to set foot in what is now the state of Maine and more than likely several of his children were born there. He married Elizabeth Tilley when she was still 15. Both of Elizabeth Tilley's parents died during the first winter in Plymouth. John Howland and George Soule were both servants when they came on the Mayflower, Howland for Governor John Carver who passed in the spring of 1621, and Soule for Edward Winslow who lost his wife during the first winter. Abigail Adams was the 6th of 15 children and her father Mayhew was an only child. Edward Adams II was the 10th of 14 children.
